

## Information on the EWP Course (cherry pickers)

The course is separated into two parts with the first part being a half day classroom course that teaches the different types of EWPs, their strengths and limits, hazard identification and control and the safe use of the EWP.

An open book assessment completes this portion of the course.

The practical portion of this course takes between 30 and 60 minutes per machine and this is a one on one assessment that covers identifying site hazards, pre-start and pre-use checks of the EWP and the safe use of all the controls and functions of the EWP.

These courses are conducted under the control of the Hire Industry (HIANZ) and form part of the Silvercard program, a nationally recognised card showing qualifications will be sent to all trainees.

## Practical Options for EWP

Self Propelled Boom Lift—can be either knuckle boom or telescoping boom type (building site staple)

Scissor Lift (building site staple)

Trailer Mounted Boom Lift (less mobile, but high availability)

Truck Mounted Boom Lift (power companies, tree trimmers)

Vertical Lifts—straight or articulated (indoor use only, warehouses etc)

Once the theory is passed then you may do all or some of the practical options listed above. If, in the future you want to complete more of these practical's, you may do so without having to pass the theory again.
