Information on the Wheels, Tracks & Rollers Endorsement Course

This is done at a time to suit the client and one of our assessors. This involves theory and practical parts. Once completed you will leave to go to the A/A or VTNZ to endorse it on your licence. There will be a charge of \$44.00 per endorsement for this at the A/A or VTNZ.

Drivotech Ltd supplies the machines for these courses in Invercargill, Mosgiel, and Cromwell but other places you will have to supply your own or we may know of a firm that would let you borrow them.

These can be done all together or separately.

Requirements for NZTA

- Must hold your full Car Licence (Other than a motorcycle licence)

Requirements for Drivotech

- Your current Drivers Licence
- Bring Steel Cap boots if you have them.
- Day Glow jacket if you have one

If you drive a special-type of vehicle that isn't a forklift on the road, you must have a R, T or W endorsement on your driver licence.

The **R Endorsement** is for vehicles that run on rollers

The **T Endorsement** is for vehicles that run on self-laying tracks

The **W Endorsement** is for vehicles that run on wheels that aren't forklifts, rollers, passenger vehicles, tractors, fire engines, trade vehicles or vehicle recovery service vehicles.

Special vehicle type	Class 1 (Full)	Class 2 (Full)	Class 4 (Full)
Runs on wheels—when driven on a road at a speed exceeding 30km/h	Not more than 6,000kg GLW Up to 18,000kg but not over 30kph	More than 6,000kg but less than 18,001kg GLW Over 18000kg but not over 30kph	More than 18,000kg GLW
Runs on rollers or self laying tracks	Not more than 18,000kg gross laden weight (GLW)	More than 18,000kg GLW	—
Runs on tracks—when driven on a road.	Not more than 18,000kg GLW	More than 18,000kg GLW	—

Wheels will let you drive a Telehandler without forks fitted.

In addition to holding the appropriate special types vehicle endorsement, you must also hold the appropriate full class of licence that covers the weight of the special-type vehicle you want to drive.
